#### JEE Main

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will administer the <u>JEE Main</u> exam in two sessions: January and April. Understanding the JEE Main exam pattern is crucial for successful preparation. The exam will be held in two shifts, morning and evening, and consist of three papers: Paper 1 (B.E/B.Tech), Paper 2A (B.Arch), and Paper 2B (B.Planning). The overall **JEE Main paper pattern** remains consistent for both sessions, though there are slight differences in the exam pattern for Paper 1 and Paper 2.

The JEE Main exam pattern provides essential details such as test duration, marking scheme, subjects, total marks, and other relevant aspects. The exam will consist of 90 questions carrying a total of 300 marks, each topic comprises 20 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) and 10 numerical value questions (NVQs). Out of the 10 NVQs, candidates are only required to answer five.

#### JEE Main Exam Pattern

The JEE Main exam pattern for consists of two papers: Paper 1 for B.E./B.Tech. and Paper 2A for B.Arch. Paper 1 is compulsory for all candidates, while Paper 2A is optional for those aspiring to pursue B.Arch. degrees. Each paper is three hours long and consists of Section A, multiple-choice questions (MCQs), and Section B, numerical value answer questions (NVQs). Candidates are required to attempt any five out of ten NVQs in Section B. Negative marking is applicable in both sections.
